Commanded an Independent Field Workshop in Eastern Ladakh. Colonel Geeta Rana has taken charge of an independent field workshop in a forward and remote location in eastern Ladakh. A woman officer has, for the first time, taken over the command of an independent unit in the sensitive Ladakh sector.



**Cmdr. Prerna Deosthalee**

First woman to command an Indian Naval Warship. (Lieutenant Commander Prerna Devasthali will be the first woman officer of the Indian Navy to command an entire warship. She has been appointed by Rear Admiral Praveen Nair, Commander of the Western Fleet. Devasthali (INS. Has been elected commanding officer of 'Rikard'.)



**Capt. Surbhi Jakhmola**

First woman officer on foreign assignment in BRD (Border Road Organisation) at Project Dantak, Bhutan.



**Gp. Capt. Shaliza Dhani**

First woman to lead a frontline combat unit in the Air Force. (Group Captain Shaliza Dhani is an officer in the Indian Air Force (IAF). She is the first woman officer in the IAF to receive a permanent commission and the first woman to become a Flight Commander.)



**Capt. Shiva Chouhan**

First woman officer deployed at Siachen, the world's highest battlefield. (Breaking the glass ceiling, Captain Shiva Chouhan of Fire and Fury Corps became the first woman officer to be operationally deployed in Siachen, the world's highest battlefield. The officer was posted at the Kumar post, located at an altitude of around 15,600 feet in Siachen in January 2023, for a three-month stint.)

the first woman officer to command the Border Roads Task Force (BRTF), is overseeing key road projects in Ladakh's Itanle along the Line of Actual Control (LAC) with China. Braving sub-zero temperatures, she aims to connect villages in the region by managing logistics and requisitioning machinery

## Bharat Ratna 2023

### **Karpoori Thakur**

Karpoori Thakur, the 11th Chief Minister of Bihar, held office for two terms: 1970-1971 and 1977-1979. In 1978, he instituted the reservation policy for state government jobs, a pivotal step towards socio-economic equity. Thakur's legacy is marked by his impactful tenure and pioneering contributions to affirmative action in Bihar.



### **Lal Krishna Advani**

Lal Krishna Advani served as the Deputy Prime Minister of India from 2002 to 2004. He played a pivotal role in the Ram Janmabhoomi movement, advocating for the construction of the Ram Temple in Ayodhya. Advani is the longest-serving leader of opposition in the Lower House of Parliament.



### **M. S. Swaminathan**

M. S. Swaminathan is renowned as the "Father of the Green Revolution in India." Serving as the Director General of the Indian Council of Agricultural Research, he played a pivotal role in revolutionizing Indian agriculture.



### **P. V. Narasimha Rao**

P. V. Narasimha Rao, the 9th Prime Minister of India (1991-1996), initiated significant economic reforms, liberalizing the Indian economy. His tenure saw the dismantling of the License Raj and the introduction of the New Economic Policy, fostering economic growth.



### **Chaudhary Charan Singh**

Chaudhary Charan Singh, the 5th Prime Minister of India (1979-1980), was a champion of farmers' rights. As a prominent judicial figure, he focused on agrarian reforms and implemented policies to address the concerns of the agricultural community.

## Places to Visit in Ramgarh Dist

### **Patratu Dam**

30 km to the west of Ramgarh, this dam was constructed with the purpose of supplying water to Patratu Thermal Power Station. Water from the river Nalkari and from the waterfalls of the hills surrounding this dam is stored in this dam. The total storage capacity of this dam is 81 square miles. It is a beautiful tourist spot and throughout the year, particularly during the winter season, a large number of people visit here for picnic. There is a circuit house beside the dam. The Pancha-wahini temple adjacent to the dam is an ancient temple and significant for its religious value.



### **Chinnamastika Mandir**

Chinnamastika Mandir is situated 28 km away from Ramgarh on the confluence of rivers Bhairavi and Damodar. This temple known as Chinnamastika temple finds place in our Vedas and Puranas and it has been recognized as an ancient and strong source of Shakti. It is believed that the person who devotes himself wholeheartedly with pious heart to Maa Chinnamastika has all his wishes fulfilled by the Goddess. Devotees from all corners of Jharkhand, Bihar and West Bengal, visit this holy place throughout the year.



### **Mayatungri Temple**

An ideal tourist spot at Ramgarh, which is also a Hindu pilgrimage centre, then the Mayatungri Temple would be the perfect choice. With its panoramic natural beauty, this temple is 5 km south of Ramgarh in the Ghutapahi Valley. It is at a height of 300 ft. Every year a local festival known as Karma is celebrated with enthusiasm by the locals and people from the neighbouring villages.



### **Tooti Jharna Temple**

Tooti Jharna Temple Situated amidst scenic surroundings at Ramgarh is the acclaimed temple dedicated to Lord Shiva, known as the Tooti Jharna Temple. It is about 7 km away from the Ramgarh Cantonment. The main attraction of this temple is that the water from unknown source flows throughout the year a canal and falls directly on the Shiva Linga. It is an ideal place to visit along with family and friends to relax in the serene atmosphere.



### **Chaitanya mahaprabhu lotus feet (Chudan Puhadi)**

The great Indian saint Chaitanya Mahaprabhu of the 15th century is considered to be the combined incarnation of Radha and Krishna in India. He explained Bhakti Yoga and popularised the chanting of the Hare Krishna maha-mantra. Chaitanya Mahaprabhu Kamal Pad is situated in (Kaju) Ramgarh of Jharkhand state is one of the famous religious places of Jharkhand. Chaitanya Mahaprabhu is believed to have spent some unique moments of his life at this place. Even today the memories of the feet of Chaitanya Mahaprabhu can be seen.

## The Greatest and Laudable achievements of India

### India witnessed the first Lok Sabha Elections in 1952

The biggest democracy in the world, India held its first general elections from October 25th, 1951, to February 21st, 1952, following the country's independence in August 1947. On May 13th 1952, the first session of Lok Sabha officially opened. There were 489 seats in the lower house & 17.3 crore people were eligible to vote. The results were such that 364 seats were won by the Indian National Congress (INC). Then, the first Lok Sabha was dissolved on April 4th, 1957, after serving its 5-year term.



### Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) formed in 1969

To advance planetary exploration and space science research alongside national development, ISRO was established in 1969. The Indian space program's founding fathers, renowned scientist Vikram Sarabhai and India's first Prime Minister Pt. Jawaharlal Nehru, who founded INCOSPAR (Indian National Committee for Space Research) in 1962, are credited with creating ISRO, the successor of INCOSPAR.



### India's first-ever rocket launch in 1963

The launch of the first sounding rocket from Thumba near Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala, on November 21st 1963, demarcated the beginning of the Indian Space Programme. Sounding rockets made it possible to probe the atmosphere in situ using rocket-borne instrumentation. This was the first milestone in modern India's space journey. Dr. Vikram Sarabhai and his then accomplice Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam, were the brainchild of this achievement.



### Powerful Defence

Post-independence, India strengthened its defence so that history does not repeat itself in situations of war. In 1954, India became the first nation to launch the Atomic Energy Program. In 1974, India conducted "Smiling Buddha", its first nuclear test, making its place on the list of five nuclear-powered nations. This test was one of the biggest achievements of India since independence. Today, India has the 2nd largest military force and largest voluntary army worldwide.



### Green Revolution

Norman Borlaug, referred to as the "Father of the Green Revolution" globally, started the Green Revolution movement in the 1960s. He was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize in 1970 due to his work creating high-yielding wheat varieties (HYVs). The Green Revolution was introduced in 1967. Despite being an agricultural state, India was food-deficient and relied heavily upon food grains import to feed the large population. So, this Green Revolution made India a self-sufficient nation. Today, India is the largest producer of pulses & the second largest producer of rice, wheat & sugarcane globally.

## The Greatest and Laudable achievements of India

### ***The 'rocket women' behind Chandrayaan-3's success***

Indians across the globe celebrated the soft landing of Chandrayaan-3 in the South Pole region of the moon. Inevitably, the first thing that comes to mind when we talk of milestone achievements by Indians in 2023: in a historic feat, ISRO's Chandrayaan-3 mission successfully landed a spacecraft in the South Pole region of the moon on 23 August 2023. This not only marked a monumental leap for space exploration but also for women who have toiled for a seat in the male-dominated field of science. Notably, over 100 women scientists and engineers contributed to this historic mission.



### ***Kartiki Gonsalves became the first Indian film director to win the Academy Award***

The Elephant Whisperers' filmmaker Kartiki Gonsalves and producer Guneet Monga accept the Academy Award for Best Documentary Short Film. Kevin Winter/Getty Images. Mumbai-based filmmaker Kartiki Gonsalves and producer Guneet Monga won the Academy Award for the Tamil documentary *The Elephant Whisperers*, making Gonsalves the first Indian film director to secure an Academy Award. Telling the story of an indigenous couple entrusted with the care of an orphaned baby elephant, the film shines a light on animal and human co-existence and clinched the *Oscar* for Best Documentary Short Film.



### ***Harmanpreet Kaur earned BBC 100 Women recognition for sports prowess***

Harmanpreet Kaur of India acknowledges the crowd after scoring 143 not out during the 2nd Royal London ODI between England Women and India Women at The Spitfire Ground on September 21, 2022 in Canterbury, England. In its 11th edition of the influential BBC 100 Women list for 2023, BBC indicated inspiring women across the globe. Among the honourees who came from diverse fields was Harmanpreet Kaur, the captain of the Indian Women's National Cricket Team. The *sportswoman* earned recognition in the Entertainment & Sports category with the achievement following her May 2023 recognition as one of Wisden's five Cricketers of the Year.



### ***Neeraj Chopra won gold at the 2023 Asian Games***

Defending his title as the world's number one javelin thrower, Neeraj Chopra clinched a gold medal at the Asian Games 2023, taking place in Hangzhou, China. With a season-best throw of 88.06m, he took the top spot at the games. Chopra is currently set to participate in the 2024 Paris Olympics, sharing that preparations are in full swing for the competition.



### ***Visually impaired Indian Women's Cricket Team won gold at the IRSA***

Under the leadership of captain Sushma Patel, the visually impaired Indian women's *cricket* team bagged the gold medal at the International Blind Sports Association (IBSA) World Games. Held at Edgbaston, Birmingham in August, the event marked a historic achievement as the *Indian team* defeated Australia by nine wickets. The 2023 IBSA Games were also the first to include cricket as a category.

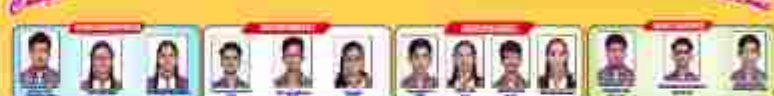

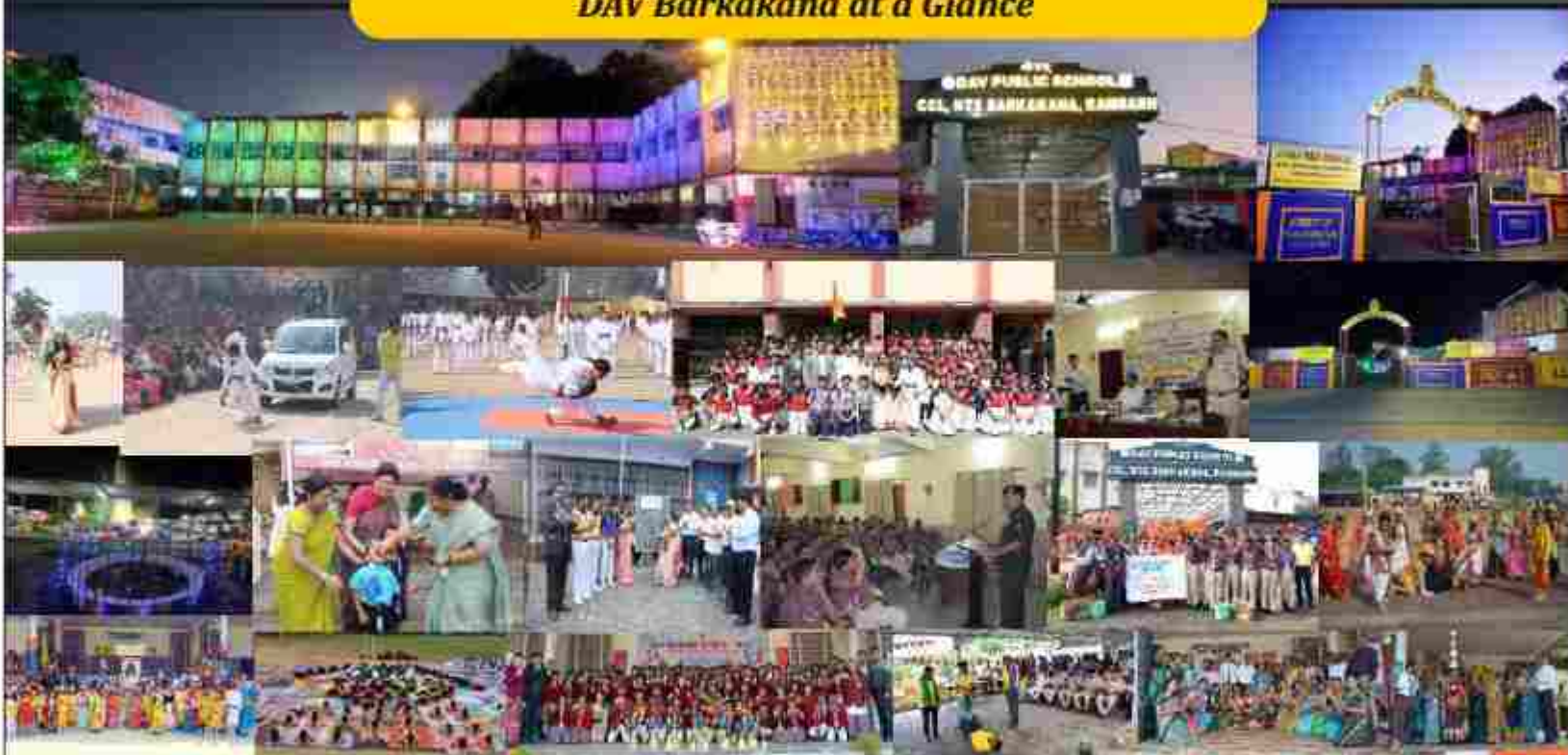
